PURITY INT'L MINISTRIES WIDOWS' PROJECT




I met with some of the women after a Sunday service and they expressed their gratitude for the gifts and donations for Christmas and the project they started.



Achieng is a young widow as well as an orphan whose husband died on a road accident. He left her with three young children. Her in-laws are giving her hard time since the death of her husband and she is having difficulty coping with the stress of her in-laws while taking care of her children.



Juma runs a small business that provides her some income to take care of her five kids and two grandchildren.





Agnes' husband was the senior pastor of this local church. He passed away in 2006 and she is now leaving with her grandson who is sick.



Pascariah has mild anemia but that doesn't stop her from walking to church every Sunday a distance of about 10 Kilometers.



Maria does not remember when she became a widow. She was hit by a motor bike one year ago and has not fully recovered because of lack of proper treatment, she has no insurance



With your financial support, these women were able to lease two farms where they planted corn and beans. They hope this project help them generate some income. It has been so dry and the beans did not so well.



They are sharing the Christmas gifts that were generously provided by your financial support. Eight women and their children were helped last year 2015.



Kerubo battles with hypertension and mild arthritis. Sometimes she is not able to afford her daily medication because of limited income

Elizabeth one of the women in the group died in April after an infection through her wounds.



Rebecca (my mom) is the leader of the group. Her husband was killed in 1992 while campaigning for a parliamentary seat in his constituency.
