Most of these widows were hopeless and vulnerable to all sorts of social vices including neglect and stigmatization but Purity Ministries has provided an umbrella that brings joy and hope to these widows.

Less than 5 years since the inception of this ministry, the impact has already been felt and the blessing is already spreading around the villages. We hope and pray that God will open His doors and provide a perfect opportunity for this ministry to expand

Among the prominent initiatives is the goats project whereby every member was given a pair of goats each. This was done in an effort to engage all the widows in farming activity so as to keep them busy and also to help them gain a living through the goats.

The vision of the goats project is to expand and circulate the goats among all the widows and also incase any new member joins. Therefore all the members were supposed to donate the first lambs when the goats give birth. These young ones are to be given to any new member and in doing so, the project is expanding and hence achieving its intended aim.

Pascal Bokono, who suffers from mild anemia and one of the oldest among the widows, was very grateful when we paid her a visit during the outreach program.

Due to her advanced old age, she has been confined to her house since she has complications in walking, and so we could not take photos with her pair of goats since they were out grazing.

Her eyesight is slowly fading and she is having difficulty in remembering things since her memory is failing.

But despite her advanced age and medical complications, Pascal is a staunch and dedicated Christian who is strongly believing in God. She is even feeling bad that

she can't rise up and attend church services every Sunday as she used to.
